

World Woman Cannes Agenda launches bold #EqualityMoonshot initiative

he prestigious Hotel Splendid Cannes will play host to the inaugural World Woman Cannes Agenda this week, bringing together over 400 delegates from more than 30 countries for a groundbreaking event focused on reshaping women's roles in media and entertainment.

The two-day summit, running May 14-15, opposite the Palais des Festivals, during the 78th Festival de Cannes, aims to foster collaboration among female creators, funders, filmmakers and changemakers under the banner #EqualityMoonshot.

"This is no longer just about inclusion it's about radical re-invention," said Rupa Dash, CEO of World Woman Foundation. "Women are not just rewriting the script

- they are engineering a new cinematic reality."

The impressive line-up features Oscarnominated actor Shohreh Aghdashloo, who will lead Still Smiling: A Cinematic Call to Action Against Domestic Violence, a powerful panel addressing gender-based violence through film. Dr Stacy L. Smith, founder of the USC Annenberg Inclusion Initiative, will engage in conversation with director Marielle Heller (*Nightbitch, A Beautiful Day in the Neighborhood*).

Brazil's Minister of Culture, Hon. Margareth Menezes, will deliver a keynote address examining the intersection of culture, policy and gender equality, while award-winning French actress Marianne Borgo will bring her insights to several panels including the opening session, The Future is Female-Led.

The event's second day features Frame the Future: Redefining Global Content Standards for Women in Media, with Dr Smith, joined by journalist Alina Trabattoni, German-Kurdish filmmaker Ayşe Polat and professor Dr Sally Nuamah.

Another highlight will be Stories That Shift Worlds & Equality Moonshot, featuring Oscar-nominated actress Veronica Ferres, director Rahmatou Keita and Indian filmmaker Nila Madhab Panda discussing narrative power in global cinema.

The agenda also includes sessions on Using Storytelling to Shift Cultural Perceptions and New Era of Identity & Global Cinema, featuring prominent voices including Brazilian cinema executive Ana Arruda and Isabél Zuaa, star of *The Secret Agent*, which is premiering in the main competition at this year's festival.

According to organisers, studies show that advancing gender equality in creative industries could add £9.3tn (\$12.3tn) to global GDP by 2025.

The World Woman Cannes Agenda represents what Dash calls "a seismic shift in storytelling" — one that is "not only inclusive but boldly re-imagining the future of media and culture" through the convergence of AI, activism and artistry.

Can you describe your company?

Protagonist Pictures is the UK-based sales, finance and production company with a proven track record of creative and commercial success. Protagonist handles films from around the world, always maintaining a strong focus on filmmakers with exceptional vision and storytelling skills. We have a very diverse slate this year including: seductive thriller *The Return* of *Stanley Atwell*, starring Nicholas Galitzine and Marisa Abela; teen killer-comedy *Hot Ted* starring Billy Magnussen, Ella Purnell and Ariana Greenblatt; and horror *The Rule of Three* from Temple Hill Entertainment, starring Thomasin McKenzie and Katie Douglas.

What is your mission in Cannes?

This year I'll be coming to Cannes wearing two hats! We've just launched a brand-new boutique label called Protagonist Picks that will sit alongside and augment the Protagonist Pictures' award-winning slate of first run features and well-established library with a mix of highquality, curated features and documentaries. We designed it as a bespoke destination for talented and visionary storytellers, with a focus on non-theatrical premium partners. The goal is to reach global audiences wherever they are and to expand storytelling avenues. I've just been elevated to director of sales, Protagonist Picks and Library, and I'm very excited to introduce Protagonist Picks to Cannes.

The other mission is to continue to expand and manage our two back catalogues, Film4 Library and Protagonist Library. We represent the work of some of the greatest filmmakers including Danny Boyle, Mike Leigh, Ken Loach, Stephen Frears, Jonathan Glazer, Paul Greengrass, Peter Greenaway, Yorgos Lanthimos, Taika Waititi, Sean Baker and Andrea Arnold.

What is an average day for you in Cannes?

Meetings, meetings and more meetings! Followed by what hopefully will be a cold glass of rosé with old friends, colleagues and clients. Over the years, I slowly swapped Cannes parties for dinners and late drinks — easier for long passionate rants about films.

Your favourite Cannes memories?

There are so many. Laughing until my belly hurts at Le Petit Majestic with my Cannes tribe who are even crazier about films than me. Walking the red carpet for a main competition premiere with my colleagues and sharing an unbelievable sense of achievement. The thrill of closing deals and knowing the films will reach their audience. Seeing familiar faces, meeting new ones. Never getting bored talking about cinema and the market. But if I had to choose one it would be my first Cannes. I was a freelancer with a paper print-out accreditation for two days only, and it was the very end of the market. That last night, after the market closed, everyone was in the international village partying. As I was walking along the Croisette, I was looking at them, wondering if I would ever feel that joy of working on something you are so passionate about. I was so close to them and yet still so removed from that world, I couldn't imagine I would one day actually be part of the industry. And all these years later,

Jordan unveils bold 45% production incentive at Cannes

he Royal Film Commission – Jordan has announced an ambitious new production incentive package offering up to 45% cash rebates for qualifying film and television projects. The announcement, made during the Cannes Film Festival, signals Jordan's determination to cement its position as a premier global filming destination.

The enhanced scheme introduces a scalable rebate system ranging from 25% to 45% on qualifying in-country expenditure. Projects with budgets exceeding \$10m that incorporate Jordanian cultural elements can access the maximum 45% rebate, determined through a points-based assessment evaluating artistic, cultural and economic contributions.


This strategic move also extends support to local filmmakers, with the rebate for domestic productions increased from 10% to 30% for projects spending over \$500,000, part of broader efforts to cultivate Jordan's homegrown talent and production capabilities.

"The amendments aim to enhance Jordan's competitiveness as a major film production hub in the region," said Mohannad Al-Bakri, managing director of the Royal Film Commission – Jordan. "We're creating a supportive environment that fosters creativity, provides robust infrastructure, and facilitates the exchange of expertise and knowledge transfer."

Jordan has already established itself as a soughtafter location for international productions, with blockbusters including *The Martian*, *Aladdin*, *Dune: Part One* and *Two* and *John Wick* filming in iconic locations such as Wadi Rum and Petra.

The initiative is expected to further drive film tourism by showcasing Jordanian landscapes and cultural heritage to global audiences.

Established in 2003, the Royal Film Commission – Jordan operates as an autonomous public institution dedicated to developing an internationally competitive Jordanian audiovisual industry through training programmes, screenings and production support services. LIZA FOREMAN

EDIA Capital Technologies has announced actor-director Eli Roth's return to the independent business after nearly a decade, through his new film, Ice Cream Man. WME Independent

is representing international sales, and the film is produced in partnership with Roth's part-fan-owned media company The Horror Section.

Written and directed by Roth, Ice Cream Man has been described as his "most terrifying and insane film yet".

"This marks the first independent film that MCT is fully financing, an expansion from



The team at MCT has financed or co-financed 150-plus films over 25 years, which collectively have grossed more than \$10bn at the global box office and have received more than 60 Academy Award nominations and 15 Oscars, including Best

Picture. "Birdman, John Wick, The Great Gatsby, Mad Max: Fury Road, The Matrix trilogy, the Ocean's series and Hereditary are some of our biggest, most iconic hits," Woodrow said.

"Theatrical films have always been a core operational model for MCT, whether it's our equity-slate co-financing with Lionsgate, our recently launched independent horror label The Horror Section — in partnership with Eli Roth — or future single-picture financing opportunities," MCT president Raj Singh added. "The theatrical experience is evergreen both from a financial standpoint and as a human, cultural ritual." But that doesn't rule out other platforms: "Strategically, we want to be educated and agile with ROIs, budgets and evolving exploitation windows, and let the content dictate the best approach to market," Singh said.

Woodrow said that the company is positioned to be "the most active financier in Hollywood in the coming years, strategically diversifying our investments across studio equity-slate co-financing, prestige single-picture financing, creditinvestment opportunities and ventureinvestment incubation".

A range of institutional investors, including Massachusetts-based MassMutual, support the company and its investment activities. "Our vision is to define what a nextgeneration studio can be: scalable and unencumbered by the traditional infrastructure and staffing requirements that often hinder growth. MCT strives to align with creative and institutional partners who share our values and are committed to shaping the future of entertainment together," he said.

Fabian&Fred marks decade of animation excellence with ambitious new ventures

amburg-based animation powerhouse Fabian&Fred celebrates its 10th anniversary with an ambitious slate of projects and a pioneering new studio launch, announced this week in Cannes.

Founded in 2015 by producer Fabian Driehorst and director Frédéric Schuld, the studio has built a portfolio of 30 films created in collaboration with 21 countries, establishing itself as one of Germany's most diverse animation studios.

"The past decade has been an incredible journey," Driehorst said. "Our goal has always been to discover exceptional talents and create animated stories that resonate across borders. With our new projects, we're focused on tailor-made strategies that connect with audiences from development

through distribution."

The studio's artistic achievements include two Oscar shortlistings and two European Film Award nominations, most recently for Sultana's Dream by Isabel Herguera, which claimed Grand Prix awards at multiple festivals. The anniversary highlight is the launch of Pom Pom Animation, Germany's first socialimpact production studio dedicated to entertaining, value-driven animated features. Co-founded with Vanessa Ciszewski of Luftkind Filmverleih as co-CEO, the Hallebased studio focuses on socially conscious animation projects. Among its upcoming releases is Heirloom by Upamanyu Bhattacharyya, which recently secured regional funding and will premiere footage at Annecy next month. "We're committed to building talent and showcasing

extraordinary directors," Driehorst added. "Our future strategy focuses on developing projects with a much stronger market orientation from the beginning, ensuring each project is tailor-made for success across all platforms."

Looking ahead, Fabian&Fred is refining its focus on children's and family animation features for theatrical release. "We're leveraging our experience to address specific market gaps with premium content that resonates with both audiences and critics," Driehorst explains, "while exploring opportunities to develop our IPs across multiple media platforms."

Cannes market heats up with star-studded projects

Marché du Film, with major sales companies unveiling star-studded packages. Pia Patatian's Cloud9

Studios is launching sales on the conspiracy thriller The Awakening, starring Peter Stormare (Fargo, John Wick: Chapter 2) and Alice Eve (Star Trek Into Darkness, Men in Black 3). Currently in post-production, the film introduces newcomer Justin Tinto alongside 2017 World's Strongest Man Eddie Hall, with Matt Hookings and twotime Oscar winner Kevin Spacey rounding out the cast. Shot at Pinewood Studios, the thriller follows a couple who uncover a global conspiracy, with director Matt Routledge helming from a screenplay co-written with Tinto and Hookings. Cloud9 Studios is also launching sales on the newly announced thriller The Old Man in the Dunes starring Aaron Eckhart. Anton is aggressively expanding its slate with four major announcements. This includes the survival thriller Left Seat which pairs Michelle Rodriguez (Fast & Furious franchise, Widows) with Golden Globewinner Richard Gere (Pretty Woman, Chicago), under the direction of Ben Younger (Bleed for This, Boiler Room). The

tense drama features Rodriguez as a

pharmaceutical rep forced to land a plane

with only radio guidance from Gere after the pilot loses consciousness mid-flight. The London-based sales outfit is also handling Vince Vaughn and Theo James starrer *The Bookie & the Bruiser*, a 1959-set gangster thriller from acclaimed director S. Craig Zahler. James and Vaughn portray WWII veterans who form an illicit gambling operation, finding themselves caught between the Mafia and an Irish gang.

Horror fans will be drawn to Anton's *The Shepherd*, starring David Dastmalchian (*Oppenheimer*, *The Dark Knight*) and Georgina Campbell (*Barbarian*). Directed by John Hyams, the horror-thriller follows a pregnant woman fleeing abuse, whose escape is hijacked by a mysterious stranger. The film reunites Dastmalchian with the producers of the box-office hit *Late Night with the Devil*.

Completing Anton's impressive line-up is the zombie-action horror *Zero Protocol*, starring Rebecca Hall (*Godzilla vs. Kong*, *The Night House*). Directed by Debs Paterson (*Halo, Willow*) and produced by Andy Serkis and Jonathan Cavendish's Imaginarium Productions, the film features Hall as an NYPD commissioner battling a city-wide zombie outbreak while her teenage daughter is trapped in the danger zone.

Meanwhile, Palisades Park Pictures is launching international sales on writerdirector Alex Vlack's debut feature *The Revisionist*, starring Academy Awardwinner Dustin Hoffman, Alison Brie, André Holland and Tom Sturridge. The psychological drama explores a novelist who manipulates people in her life into characters for her story, causing her world to descend into secrets and betrayal.

Temple Hill Entertainment and Protagonist Pictures have re-teamed on The Rule of Three, the first installment in a new horror trilogy adapted from bestselling thriller author Sam Ripley's novel of the same name. The announcement came today from Protagonist Pictures' CEO, Dave Bishop. The film stars Thomasin McKenzie (JoJo Rabbit,Last Night in Soho) and Katie Douglas (Clown in a Cornfield, Netflix's Ginny & Georgia). James Roday Rodriguez (Gravy) directs, adapted from a screenplay by Todd Harthan (Hulu''s High Potential) and Rodriguez. Marty Bowen, Wyck Godfrey and Isaac Klausner will produce for Temple Hill, with Hal Sadoff and George Berman executive producing.

BAFTA-, Golden Globe- and Emmy-Award nominee Michael Sheen and Emmy- and SAG-Award winner Eva Longoria are set to star in the new holiday comedy *The 12 Days of Christmas*, directed by BAFTAnominee Ben Gregor and written by Tad Safran, based on the bestselling novel *The 12 Topsy-Turvy Very Messy Days of Christmas*, co-written by James Patterson and Tad Safran. Protagonist Pictures is also launching sales at the Cannes Film Market.

Taiwan Territory Report A resilient film industry navigating global shifts

Taiwan has emerged as a hub for Chinese-language content production. Dazzling locations, lack of censorship and supportive industry bodies signal more success. – BY LIZA FOREMAN

aiwan has grown its Chinese-language production industry, particularly as Western entertainment companies have scaled back operations in mainland China and Hong

Kong. This strategic positioning has allowed Taiwan to capitalise on its democratic values, media freedoms and cultural plurality to attract international productions and streaming platforms seeking a foothold in the Asian market.

As China has made business dealings increasingly difficult for Western entertainment and tech companies, Taiwan has deliberately positioned itself as the default production centre for outward-facing Chinese-language television and film content. The island's government has substantially transformed its approach to the entertainment industry over the past four years, shifting from a ministry-led bureaucracy to a more dynamic funding and promotional role.

The Taiwan Creative Content Agency (TAICCA), established in 2019 under the Ministry of Culture, serves as a professional intermediary organisation working to promote Taiwan's content industries across film, television, publishing, pop music and animation. TAICCA has rapidly expanded its influence by venture-funding local enterprises, launching the Taiwan Creative Content Fest (TCCF) market in 2020, and supporting film co-productions through its

Q&A WITH

HOMME TSA TAICCA CHAIRPERSON

What are the main challenges in the film business in your territory?

Following the pandemic, a clear division has emerged in the film market between blockbusters and indie films, potentially influenced by increasing ticket prices and the diverse entertainment options accessible to audiences.

The declining audience numbers reflect the challenges that the industry faces. In 2023, the average production cost of Taiwanese movies (including documentaries) was NT\$42.62m (\$1.43m), marking a significant increase from 2022. The rise in production budgets is linked to external factors such as inflation, rising minimum wages, and increased awareness of labour conditions and workplace safety, all of which have contributed to higher production costs.

However, the rising costs of production fees do not mean that audiences will choose Taiwanese films over Hollywood blockbusters or animation films. In 2024, the number-one blockbuster was Disney animation *Inside Out 2*, earning nearly twice the top Taiwanese film, *Gatao*.

The popularity of international OTT platforms might be another reason that audiences do not visit cinema regularly. According to TAICCA's survey, in 2022, 60% of interviewees said they visited cinemas, a significant drop in comparison to 2020's 66% International OTT platforms are also more accessible to local audiences. Local audiences have access to international platforms: Netflix, YouTube, Disney+ and HBO GO. TAICCA's survey also shows that in 2023, Netflix topped the chart as 62% of interviewees have used the platform.



What are some new initiatives to support the filmmaking community?

In recent years, TAICCA has placed significant emphasis on fostering international collaborations, particularly in the areas of co-investment, co-production and talent development and exchange. We have teamed up with several leading organisations, including Federation Studios and BPIfrance in France; Blintn, Central Investment Partners and production companies such as Mr. Romance and Moving Pictures Co. in Korea; as well as Gold House in North America. Through these strategic alliances, we are working to strengthen Taiwan's audiovisual industry and actively create more opportunities for international collaboration.

Also, TAICCA has initiated several programmes targeting international co-developments, thereby motivating cross-border co-prodoctions, mainly in two patterns as below:

production companies: call for Taiwanese projects and select a number of them to co-develop with the partner. 'ROCKET Program: Chinese-Language Genre Film' aims to develop romance, horror and action feature films scripts by co-operating with prominent partners from South Korea (Bound Entertainment), Thailand (Transformation Films) and Indonesia (Sinemart Production). TAICCA is also aligning with distinguished South Korean companies such as Something Special, Imaginus and SLL to facilitate film, drama series and unscripted format co-developments.

- B. Financial backing for Taiwanese teams collaborating with international talents: 'Taiwan



supports feature-film projects to develop full scripts with Taiwanese elements teaming up with international creators, with approximately US\$180,000 for each project; while 'International Writers Program' aims at series projects joining forces with international professionals aiding in script developing, with approximately US\$ 65,000 for each project.

Did your box office decline or grow in 2024?

According to the statistics provided by the Taiwan Film and Audiovisual Institute, in 2024 the total box office sales is NT\$6,201,008,728 (\$190,556,998). In comparison with 2023's sales number NT\$7,656,810,664 (\$235,293,791), the decrease of box office sales is NT\$14,558,019 (\$447,367), representing a 19% decline. ■ International Co-funding Program (TICP). Taiwan's appeal to international productions extends beyond political considerations. The island boasts a rich variety of climatic zones, diverse landscapes and welldeveloped transportation infrastructure. Film content is not subject to governmental censorship, and production can proceed without government approval — factors that have attracted renowned directors including Ang Lee (*Life of Pi*), Luc Besson (*Lucy*), and Martin Scorsese (*Silence*).

The territory's LGBTQ-friendly environment — Taiwan legalised same-sex marriage in May 2019, becoming the first in Asia to do so — has further enhanced its attractiveness for diverse storytelling.

Evidence of Taiwan's growing international film presence can be seen in its participation in major film festivals. At the 2024 Berlinale, Taiwanese companies were minority co-producers on four films, including two in competition, with originating countries as diverse as Mauritania, Nepal, India and Brazil. Taiwan-based icon Tsai Ming-liang also returned to Berlin with a new US-coproduced title and a restored version of his 2005 Silver Bear-winning film.

Despite these successes, Taiwan's domestic box office, like many territories worldwide. has not fully recovered from the COVID-19 pandemic. Fewer commercially oriented Taiwanese films are achieving success in local cinemas, pushing producers to seek alternative revenue sources and international partnerships. The introduction of TAICCA's upgraded International Co-funding Program (TICP 2.0) initially faced resistance from over 100 local filmmakers concerned about cultural criteria and funding transparency, prompting the agency to revise its approach. As Taiwan continues to navigate these challenges, its film industry stands at a crucial juncture. The balance between nurturing domestic talent and stories while expanding international co-productions will determine the future trajectory of this dynamic and resilient film territory.

FILMING IN TAIWAN

INCENTIVES & SUPPORT

Foreign film production companies filming in Taiwan can access substantial financial support from multiple sources:

- **BAMID Support:** Up to 30% of costs spent in Taiwan, with a maximum limit of approximately US\$1m for feature films and US\$600,000 for television dramas.
- Combined Support: Total financial support from BAMID, TAICCA and local government agencies (Taipei, Taichung, Kaohsiung) can reach up to 50% of Taiwan expenditure, with BAMID still providing up to US\$1m.
- VAT Refund: Production companies from countries with reciprocal treatment can apply for a 5% VAT refund on goods or services expenses.
- TICP 2.0: TAICCA's co-funding programme facilitates large-scale investments to promote international collaboration and co-production projects across cultural and creative industries.

TAIPEI FILM COMMISSION MARKS 18 YEARS OF INDUSTRY SUPPORT

he Taipei Film Commission (TFC), established in late 2007 as a semi-governmental body backed by the Taipei City Government, has evolved into a key facilitator for domestic and international productions filming in Taiwan's capital.

Operating with a dual mandate of governmental authority and operational flexibility, the TFC provides services ranging from location scouting and traffic management to talent development. The organisation also supports broader industry development through policy initiatives at both local and national levels.

Since its founding, the TFC has developed

practical resources including an online location database and streamlined administrative procedures designed to reduce bureaucratic obstacles for production companies.

In 2018, the commission launched the Taipei Film Fund with annual funding of NT\$15m (approximately \$489,000) specifically targeting international co-productions. According to official figures, between 2018 and 2025, the fund invested NT\$103m across 24 projects with a combined production budget of NT\$1.64bn.

These co-productions have involved partnerships with 14 countries, resulting in 160 festival appearances and 41 awards. The initiative forms part of Taiwan's broader strategy to position itself as a filmmaking destination in the Asia-Pacific region.

Industry analysts note that the TFC aims to strengthen Taiwan's position in the global film market by attracting international investment, enhancing Taipei's visibility abroad, and establishing the island as a production partner for international projects.

Despite these efforts, the TFC continues to face competition from neighbouring film hubs in South Korea, Japan and Southeast Asia, all vying for production investment in an increasingly globalised industry landscape.

TAIWAN CREATIVE CONTENT FEST (TCCF)

he Taiwan Creative Content Fest (TCCF), established in 2019, has rapidly evolved into a cornerstone event in the Asian creative content industry. Serving as a crucial bridge between Taiwan's entertainment sector and global markets, TCCF has established itself as a vital platform for cross-cultural exchange and business development.

The upcoming sixth edition, scheduled for November 4-7, 2025, at the Taipei Nangang Exhibition Center, follows last year's record-breaking success that attracted nearly 1,800 professionals from 35 countries and garnered 15,000 total visits. This significant turnout underscores the event's growing international recognition and Taiwan's increasing influence in the Asian content marketplace.

TCCF's architecture rests on three strategic pillars: Pitching, Market, and Forum. For 2025, the Pitching section will undergo substantial expansion, increasing its "Feature Film" session to accommodate 20 selected projects. A notable innovation is the introduction of the "Series Themed Session: If Romance Comes Again," responding to the global appetite for Asian romantic content.

The Market component will scale up international participation by inviting more countries to establish national pavilions and increasing the number of international buyers. This strategic growth aims to enhance exhibitors' market reach, improve content visibility, and generate more substantial trading opportunities for participants.

In recognition of the seismic shifts reshaping the global entertainment landscape, the Forum section will address critical industry challenges, focusing on navigating change in an era of market disruption, Al-driven technological innovation, and evolving audience consumption patterns. This forward-looking approach positions TCCF as not merely a marketplace but a thought leadership platform guiding the industry's future direction.

TCCF represents Taiwan's commitment to positioning itself as a content hub that bridges East and West, tradition and innovation, reflecting the territory's unique value proposition in the global entertainment ecosystem.

LEADING STREAMERS

Taiwan's streaming landscape is dominated by international platforms alongside regional players. The top five streaming services in the territory are:

1. NETFLIX

Leading international platform investing heavily in Taiwanese original content. In early 2024, Netflix unveiled its Chineselanguage original productions slate, featuring exclusively Taiwanese productions.

2. YOUTUBE

Widely used for both usergenerated content and professional media. Serves as a significant platform for independent creators and traditional media companies expanding their digital presence.

3. DISNEY+

Global entertainment giant bringing international content to the Taiwanese market while gradually incorporating local and regional Asian programming.

4. LINE TV

Regional platform with strong ties to the popular messaging app Line, offering a mix of Taiwanese, Japanese, Korean, and other Asian content.

5. IQIYI

Originally mainland Chinese streaming platform maintaining

a significant presence in the Taiwanese market with a focus on Chinese-language content.

The shift toward Taiwanese production is particularly notable as Western entertainment companies have reduced their footprint in mainland China and Hong Kong due to increasing business difficulties and regulatory concerns, including censorship and national security issues.

epresenting an expanded presence in the Official Selection this year, Germany is making its mark at the Cannes Film Festival with an impressive line-up of four feature-length films and three shorts across various

programme sections, including a coveted spot in the main competition.

The German Pavilion, meanwhile, designed for the first time by Maz & Movie, is expected to be a bustling hub at Village International Riviera where filmmakers, producers and industry professionals can converge throughout the festival fortnight.

"The German Pavilion will be a meeting place for filmmakers and also an information point for professionals and market attendees," said Simone Baumann, managing director of German Films. "Visitors will find all the information on the German productions and co-productions screening in the various festival sections."

The pavilion, organised in partnership with Germany's film funds including FilmFernsehFonds Bayern and Film- und Medienstiftung NRW, serves as both an information centre and networking space, hosting numerous events including happy hours and co-production meetings.

The crown jewel of Germany's Cannes presence this year is *Sound of Falling* by director Mascha Schilinski, selected for the main competition. This atmospheric drama weaves together the stories of four women from different time periods whose lives mysteriously intersect at a farmstead in the Altmark region, where buried traumas and secrets gradually surface.

Beyond the main competition, German cinema makes its presence felt throughout other festival

sections. Acclaimed filmmaker Fatih Akin presents his 12th directorial work *Amrum* in the Cannes Première sidebar. Co-written with Hark Bohm, this historical drama follows a boy unravelling a dark family secret during the final week of the Second World War.

In the same section, *The Disappearance of Josef Mengele* directed by Kirill Serebrennikov and starring German actor August Diehl chronicles the notorious Nazi doctor's fugitive years in South America.

Meanwhile, Christian Petzold completes his trilogy on elemental spirits in German Romanticism with *Miroirs No. 3* screening in the independent Quinzaine des Cinéastes sidebar. The drama centres on a music student coming to terms with loss while navigating complicated family dynamics. Industry-focused events include Animation Germany's participation in Animation Day on May 18, at the Palais des Festivals, targeting professionals from the animation sector. The German delegation is also co-hosting a Docs Happy Hour on May 19, while the Next Generation Short Tiger programme will hold its international premiere as a market screening at Olympia 2.

The pavilion will host two open happy hours on May 15 and 18, welcoming international guests from across the film industry on a first-come, first-served basis.

This robust German presence reflects a renaissance in the country's cinema, bringing diverse storytelling and creative vision to one of the world's most prestigious film festivals. With representation spanning competition films, special screenings and industry initiatives, Germany has firmly positioned itself at the heart of this year's Cannes conversation.
